**MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF PLAINTIFFS' MOTION TO  
SUBPOENA CRITICAL EVIDENCE PRIOR TO DISCOVERY**

PLAINTIFFS, BRUCE ANDERSON and WENDY ANDERSON (the  
Andersons), On behalf of themselves (in propria persona) state  
as follows:

Exhibit One is a sample of the Amway formal conciliation on  
October 11<sup>th</sup>, 2002. Now that it is suspected that the cast of the  
Amway African Safari video has been assigned to aid in the  
attack to destroy the Andersons, this event has greater meaning.  
This formal conciliation was an internal corporate kangaroo  
court held to harass and investigate the Andersons as to their  
knowledge of Amway's criminal activity. It is now obvious that  
it was a method to position the Andersons to be destroyed by  
Amway's arbitrators. Keep in mind that in October of 2002, the  
Andersons had no knowledge of 1) the baboon video 2) the

concealed court Order dated September 6<sup>th</sup>, 2000 and 3) Amway's criminal involvement to conceal this activity. Amway, once again, was masquerading as an ally to the Andersons while the entire time, setting the stage to destroy us. Jody Victor and Billy Florence approached Anderson and claimed to want to help protect Anderson from Gooch on behalf of Amway. This is a typical racketeering scenario; whereas, the attacker is posing as an ally.

The "HEARING PANEL" was made up of Jody Victor, Billy Florence, Jerry Meadows and Beverly Sallee, all of which are suspected to be on the baboon execution video. "ALSO PRESENT" was Hal Gooch and his wife Susan (on the baboon video) and Bruce Anderson (on the phone). Ray Miller (Gooch employee), Dan Bailey (Amway employee) and the rest, Steve McDonald, Bill West and Sharon Grider are lawyers for Gooch and Amway.

We start on page 123 L7 where Mr. West is doing his best to establish the extent of Anderson's knowledge of the concealed Federal Court Order dated September 6<sup>th</sup>, 2000. The question is "There was a point in time when your lawyer proceeded to execution against the causes of action that Mr. Luster had against Mr. Gooch before the judgment. Do you remember that?" My answer: "NO". This answer and this line of questioning must have brought great relief to this kangaroo court. My "Amway lawyer" Donald Christopher, was nowhere to be found and was doing a good job keeping me in the dark and concealing my own paperwork as well as Amway's criminal activity.

Mr. West goes on to exhaust the line of questioning. At one point (pg.124 L18) he comes right out and asks "why didn't you take the lawsuit?" Then later he says (Pg125 L17) "And you also own the lawsuit Luster has against Gooch".

This "formal conciliation" of Amway's was nothing more than an investigation by the cast of the baboon video and Amway to discover the extent of knowledge Anderson possessed of Amway's criminal manipulation of the officers and documents of the Florida State Courts.

THEREFORE: In the interest of justice, the Andersons request this court to order the video of Mr. Gooch shooting the baboon to be viewed by Anderson, and demand Amway to provide a complete list of attendees on the Amway African Safari.
