ORDER

THIS CAUSE is before the Court on the Motion to Proceed Pro Hac Vice (Dkt. No. 34) filed on January 29, 2008, on behalf of Timothy Q. Delaney, and the Motion to Proceed Pro Hac Vice (Dkt. No. 35) filed on January 29, 2008, on behalf of Jon H. Beaupre. In the motions, Timothy Q. Delaney and Jon H. Beaupre seek permission from the Court to appear pro hac vice in this matter on behalf of Defendant Quixtar, Inc. with Sarah G. Maroon as local counsel. Defendant Quixtar, Inc. represents to the Court that Plaintiffs object to the relief requested in the motions.¹ However, Messrs. Delaney and Beaupre have submitted the information and fee necessary under Rule 2.02, Local Rules, United States District Court, Middle District of Florida to permit them to appear pro hac vice in this matter.
